



## 2020 FEES SCHEDULE

The annual fee covers the costs of tuition, excursions and compulsory camps and retreats. Reductions in fees will be made where:

- Families hold a Health Care Card and are eligible for assistance under the Victorian Governments' Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) program.
- Sisters are attending the College at the same time.
- Payment in full is received by 28 February 2020.

**Assistance for Health Care Card holders** – As camps, retreats and excursions are included in our fees, the \$225 provided by the State under its CSEF program will be applied to family accounts. As families who meet the CSEF criteria also attract additional grant support, a further \$1,000 reduction (per student) will be applied.

**Sibling discounts** - The annual tuition fee will be reduced by 10% for a 2<sup>nd</sup> daughter and 50% for a 3<sup>rd</sup> daughter attending MSJ in 2020. This discount does not apply to the laptop learning programme.

**Additional program fees** – Extra-curricular activities that are available at additional cost include music, interstate / overseas trips and VET / VCAL courses undertaken at a TAFE. These programs are only available to students where annual fees have been or are being settled in accordance with an approved payment option listed in the above schedule.

**1 to 1 laptop learning programme** – Laptops and accessories provided by the College remain the property of the College for the 3 years of the arrangement. Ownership will only be transferred to families where enrolment is maintained for the duration of the arrangement and all fees are paid in accordance with an approved payment option (listed above). Laptop insurance excess charges are due and payable when invoiced.

*Families who provide their own laptops under the BYOSD (years 7 & 8) and BYOD (years 10 & 11) programmes will not be charged a laptop learning programme fee.*

**Payment methods** - The College accepts BPay, cash, cheques, credit cards (Visa & Mastercard), direct debits and Centrepay authorities.

**Pro rata fees** - Pro-rata fees apply where a student enrolls during a year. A pro-rata reduction is made for students leaving MSJ provided a minimum of 6 weeks' notice is provided and an exit interview is attended. 6 weeks' tuition fees are imposed in lieu of notice unless granted an exemption during the exit process.

**Please note** that fees must be finalised by 28 September. Statements will be issued during 2020 so that families can monitor their account. If difficulties are experienced, families should contact the College in writing and include a proposal for settlement of the account. Any alternative arrangement would apply for 2020 only
